What is PrEP?

Pre-exposure prophylaxis, or PrEP, is the daily use of anti-HIV medication that keeps HIV negative people from becoming infected with HIV. So far only one pill, Truvada, has been approved for this use, but additional studies are in progress to find additional drugs that could be used, and other ways of taking them. This is an exciting new area in HIV prevention research! whatisprep.org/
